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NI BEEF INDUSTRY SNAPSHOT MARCH 2015

HE beef industry snap shot provides a useful summary of the NI beef market and allows us to compare current market conditions with the same month the previous year.

During March 2015 the average R3 steer price in NI was 353.3p/kg compared to 339.8p/kg during March 2014. This is a four per cent increase year on year. Meanwhile the average R3 steer price in GB during March 2015 was 360.4p/kg putting the differential between NI and GB at 7.1p/kg for March 2015. In March 2014 the differential in R3 steer prices was 27.7p/kg.

R3 steer prices in ROI during March 2015 averaged 293p/kg compared to 315.3p/kg during the corresponding period in 2014. This 24.5p/kg decline in the R3 steer price year on year represents a 7.1 per cent drop in sterling terms. This can be partly attributed to the 13 per cent drop in the value of euro against sterling year on year. This has widened the differential in R3 steer prices between NI and ROI from 24.5p/kg in March 2014 to 60.3p/kg in March 2015.

Prime cattle slaughterings in NI during March 2015 totalled 27,305 head, an 11 per cent increase on year earlier levels. An increase in beef production from prime cattle in NI during March 2015 was also driven by a 7.8kg increase in average carcase weights year on year to 337.5kg.

Meanwhile cow slaughterings during March 2015 totalled 5,795 head, a two per cent reduction on the 5,922 killed in March 2014 with the average carcase weight down slightly to 305.4kg in March 2015.

Imports of cattle for direct slaughter during March 2015 totalled 2,238 head and accounted for 6.6 per cent of the total NI cattle kill in March 2015. In March 2014 the 1,928 cattle imported for direct slaughter accounted for 5.9 per cent of the total cattle kill.

Exports out of NI for direct slaughter during March 2015 were 19.6 per cent lower than year earlier levels with 1,122 cattle exported. Cattle exports to ROI during March 2015 totalled 1,012 head, the majority of which were cows. In March 2014

exports from NI to ROI totalled 496 head. Meanwhile exports of cattle from NI to GB for direct slaughter declined from 899 head in March 2014 to 110 head in March 2015. This reflects the narrowing of the GB/NI price differential.

The latest APHIS figures have indicated a tightening in cattle numbers on the ground with the number of beef sired cattle aged 12-30 months down 4 per cent on year earlier levels during March 2015 with the number of dairy sired male cattle back 6 per cent year on year.

On a more promising note calf registrations have shown a notable improvement in recent months with beef sired calf registrations totalling 30,437 head in March 2015, a 26.4 per cent increase on the previous March when 24,080 beef sired calves were registered. The number of dairy sired male calves has also increased with 8,776 registered in March 2015 compared to 7,355 in March 2014.
