

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

Deadweight Cattle Trade

This week base quotes for in spec U-3 grade prime cattle remained steady at 460-468p/kg however paid prices continue to indicate that higher prices are available than these quotes suggest. Base quotes for cows also remained steady this week ranging from 364-374p/kg for good quality 0+3 grading cows. Preliminary base quotes for next week indicate a similar trade.

Last week deadweight cattle prices in NI continued to come under pressure with decreases reported across the majority of grades. The average steer price last week was back 4.2p/kg from the previous week to 476.5p/kg with the average heifer price back by 3.3p/kg to 477.3p/kg. Meanwhile the average cow price in NI last week was back 5.4p/kg to 360.4p/kg a similar trade to prices reported back in early April.

In GB last week the deadweight cattle trade also continued to tighten across all of the regions for the majority of grades when compared to the previous week. The average steer price in GB last week decreased by 4.8p/kg to 486.9p/kg with the average heifer price back 3.1p/kg to 486p/kg.

Last week the deadweight cattle trade in ROI declined across all reported grades for the third consecutive week, with the cattle trade in ROI tightening over the last six weeks. The R3 steer price was back by the equivalent of 4.7p/kg from the previous week to 445.2p/kg with the R3 heifer price back 3p/kg to 449.5p/kg.



Sheep Trade

Base quotes from local processors for R3 grading lambs this week ranged from 630-640p/kg paying up to 21kg, with similar base quotes expected early next week. The deadweight lamb price in NI last week decreased by 14.5p/kg from the previous week to 631p/kg, with a stronger liveweight trade reported across the marts this week.

Last week 8,165 lambs were processed locally, 687 more than the week prior. A further 1,935 lambs were exported to ROI for direct slaughter last week, back 693 head from the previous week.
