



#### **Deadweight Cattle Trade**

Base quotes from the NI plants for in spec U-3 prime cattle ended this week ranging from 432-446p/kg. Mid week quotes for O+3 grading cows improved to range from 324-340p/kg. Similar quotes are expected for all types of cattle early next week.

Last week in NI the deadweight trade for cattle firmed across a number of grades from the previous week. While the average price paid for steers last week was back by 1.2p/kg to 444.2p/kg. The average R3 steer price reported only a marginal decline of 0.2p/kg bringing it to 457p/kg. The average price paid for R3 heifers in NI last week was also reported at 457p/kg, up just over half a penny from the previous week, while the average heifer price was up by a similar margin to 446.1p/kg. Last week for the first time in eleven weeks, the average cow price in NI reported an increase, bringing it to 298.5p/kg.

Last week the deadweight cattle trade in GB reported widespread improvements on the previous week. Scotland and the Midlands and Wales saw the largest uplift in trade across the regions, notably for heifers where the average price paid was up 5.6p/kg and 3p/kg respectively week on week. Meanwhile, the average heifer price in GB last week was up 2.9p/kg to 455p/kg.

In ROI last week deadweight cattle prices continued to decline in both sterling and euro terms. The R3 steer price in ROI was the equivalent of 398.3p/kg, back 6p/kg from the previous week while the R3 heifer price was back 6.2p/kg to the equivalent of 401.2/kg. The O3 cow price in ROI last week was 329.8p/kg.



#### Sheep Trade

Base quotes for R3 lambs ended this week at 530p/kg, with quotes of 515-530p/kg expected early next week. Improved quotes are reflective of the trade with the deadweight lamb price in NI last week up by 13.9p/kg from the previous week to 524.8p/kg. Steady supplies of lambs are coming forward for slaughter with 10,697 head processed last week, an increase of 929 head from the previous week. Meanwhile, 5,962 lambs were exported to ROI plants for direct slaughter last week, an increase of 1,363 head or 30 per cent on the previous week. In ROI last week the average deadweight lamb price also increased from the previous week by 1.5p/kg, bringing it to 530.9p/kg.
