Deadweight Cattle Trade

Steady levels of both prime cattle and cows were slaughtered in NI last week compared to the week previous, with prime cattle throughput in local plants totalling 7,301 head and 2,921 cows slaughtered locally. Beef supplies on NI farms remain tight and the strengthening deadweight trade continues to reflect this, with stronger quotes received for next week. Last week strong levels of cattle were imported from ROI for direct slaughter locally. Prime cattle imports totalled 170 head with 127 cows also imported. Meanwhile two prime cattle and 25 cows were exported from NI for direct slaughter in ROI last week, with no cattle making the journey to GB for direct slaughter.

The average price paid across all cattle categories continued to increase in NI last week. The overall average steer price was up by 2.9p/kg to 460.4p/kg, while the average price paid for an R3 grade steer last week was up 1.9p/kg from the previous week to 470.5p/kg. The overall average heifer price was up by 1.2p/kg to 459.7p/kg, while the average R3 heifer price declined by a marginal 0.3p/kg to 469.1p/kg. The young bull trade has also continued to improve in NI with an overall average price of 443.2p/kg last week, up 4.3p/kg from the previous week. The NI 03 cow price increased by 2.5p/kg to 313.3p/kg, while the overall average cow price was up by 3.6p/kg to 278.4p/kg compared to the previous week.

The beef trade also continued to firm across GB and ROI last week. In GB the average R3 steer price was 491.2p/kg, up 0.7p/kg from the previous week while the average steer price was up 1.7p/kg to 484.8p/kg. In ROI the average R3 steer price was the equivalent of 422p/kg an increase the equivalent of 5p/kg.

Base quotes from the major lamb processing plants this week for R3 grade lambs remained steady on last weeks levels at 530-535p/kg up to 22kg. Similar base quotes are expected next

week. Strong numbers of lambs continue to come forward for

slaughter, with throughput last week totalling 11,852 lambs. In

comparison, during the corresponding week of 2022 lamb throughput in NI plants totalled 10,812 head. The average weight of lamb carcases processed in NI last week was 21.9kg.


