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



Deadweight Cattle Trade

A strong cattle throughput was recorded in NI plants last week with the prime cattle kill totalling 8,028 head. This was up 1,138 head from the previous week, and the highest weekly prime throughput in NI during the year to date. Last week the local cow kill totalled 2,263 head which was back 335 from the previous week. Meanwhile last week levels of prime cattle imported from ROI for direct slaughter increased by 44 head to a total of 281 head. Direct slaughter cow imports totalled 157 head, back 118 week on week. Exports of cattle for direct slaughter in ROI last week totalled 15 steers and six cows, 22 head less than the previous week when four prime and 39 cull cattle were exported.

Last week reported cattle prices in NI were up across the majority of grades for all types of cattle; albeit at a slower rate than recent weeks. The average price paid for steers and heifers increased by 0.6p/kg and 1.3p/kg from the previous week to 475.3p/kg and 476.7p/kg respectively. The average price paid for U3 grade prime cattle recorded marginal declines across all categories last week. The average young bull price in NI was back half a penny from the previous week to 456.1p/kg, with the average cow price recording a similar decline to an average of 303.4p/kg. The average price paid for P grading cows was back on the previous week while the trade for O3 cows was up 2.2p/kg to 339.5p/kg.

Across the water the trade was similar to NI with few grades reporting declines from the previous week, while in ROI last week the deadweight cattle trade was back in both euro and sterling terms.

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Deadweight Sheep Trade

Base quotes for R3 grade hoggets early next week are expected to range from 610 - 615p/kg across the major processors with all plants expecting to pay up to 22.5kg. Strengthening prices have been reported for all types of hoggets. The average price paid for an R3 grade hogget in NI last week was 580.9p/kg an increase of 10.3p/kg from the previous week. Moreover last week the average deadweight price paid for hoggets was 578.2p/kg an increase of 8.2p/kg from the previous week. Meanwhile demand was evident in the sales rings last week with the average price paid for liveweight hoggets up 13.1p/kg from the previous week to 536.8p/kg.

Tight supplies of hoggets locally and a strong demand from ROI processors are driving the strengthening trade locally. In the marts this week smaller hogget numbers were met with a strong demand which strengthened as the week progressed. In Ballymena top reported prices for fat hoggets reached 673p/kg with an average price of 577p/kg paid. The trade for ewes is also strong despite strong numbers on offer, with a strong GB market reported to be upholding the local ewe trade. The top reported price paid for fat ewes last week was £275.
